Gospel Echoes Thrift Store Staff Policies

1. Volunteer and Staff Purchases

Volunteers and staff (Paid and non-paid) are not permitted to price their own purchases. Please ask management to price your item. If management is not around, please ask one of the other volunteers.

All staff purchases must have a price sticker on it and be brought to the cash register and paid for the same day, unless otherwise arranged with management.

If a cashier is buying something, he or she must allow a different cashier to ring it through the till. We understand that staff may not always have time to try items on, so staff are allowed to return items of clothing within 1 week of purchase, but they must have the original price tag still on it and also have a receipt.

2. Please don't gossip

If you have a concern about a staff member please tell management. If you have a concern about the manager, then contact the board of directors and they will address the concern. (The board member contact information is hanging in the staff room.) It does a lot of damage when we tell people that have nothing to do with the problem.

3. Cashiers and staff that deal with customers

Please do your absolute best to treat customers with respect. Be very careful what you say because there are a lot of people listening and when we are working here, we represent Gospel Echoes and as Christians we represent Christ.

4. Apparel

All clothes must be work-appropriate.

Clothes that are too revealing or inappropriate aren't allowed.

Staff must avoid clothes with stamps that are offensive or inappropriate.

We appreciate our volunteers a lot and we thank you for your service to this place and to Gospel Echoes. Please understand that these policies are a guardrail in keeping us on track. We want to keep our workings here fair and honest.
